

TRANSITIONAL HOUSING FOR FORMER FOSTER YOUTH

Expansion & Recent Policy Changes

As of July 1, 2022, exciting changes were made to transitional housing for former foster youth in California:

- **Increase in program length:** The Transitional Housing Program-Plus (THP-Plus) increased from a two-year to a three-year program, and youth can now access THP-Plus until they turn 25 instead of 24.
- **Capacity expansion:** The 2022-23 state budget included an annual \$25.3 million to expand the number of youth that can be served from approximately 1,300 to 2,100 youth, directed to the Transitional Housing Program administered by the CA Department of Housing and Community Development.
